
DRIVER IMPROVEMENT TRAINING

This program was designed to provide you with the knowledge and performance capabilities to safely interact in the highway transportation system as a defensive driver.

Driving is the most important skill in our society, as far as the threat to human life is concerned. This course can make the difference between life and death, health and injury. Every year, more than 45,000 people die as a result of motor vehicle crashes. Vehicle crashes and infractions have a major impact on how much it costs to operate a motor vehicle: insurance, property damage, health care cost, and with driving conditions getting more challenging each year due to overcrowding, cell phone usage, distracted and drowsy driving, road rage and other factors, it is essential that every driver be trained to drive safely and defensively: for both safety and economic reasons.



SIGNS TO LIVE BY

You cannot travel a public road without seeing various signs. Signs guide and protect travelers. The Bible gives us signs as well. Following these signs can lead to a personal relationship with God.

The first sign is a "Dead End" sign. The path of sin (willful disobedience to God) is a dead-end street. "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 6:23).

Jesus died on a cross to provide a way for our disobedience to God to be forgiven.

The second road sign is a "Stop" sign. Who is to stop? All are to stop and realize that they are guilty of sin. There are no exceptions to this sign, "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23). Our best efforts at being good fall short of what God wants from us. Every person must make a willful decision to turn away from sin and turn to God in faith.

The third road sign is a "One Way" sign. You might ask, "How can I be saved and know for sure that I will have eternal life with Jesus in Heaven?" There is only one-way: through personal faith in Jesus Christ. The Bible says, "That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9).

The last sign is the "Yield" sign. The Bible tells us we should let Jesus be the leader of our lives. Jesus becomes a constant companion to guide you through the highways of life. God says you need to change drivers and allow Him to have control. "But as many as received him, to them gave the power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His name" (John 1:12).

God, through His Holy Spirit, may be telling you of your need for Jesus. Ask Jesus to come into your life and be your personal Savior. Being convinced that I am a sinner and that Christ died for sinners I now repent of my sin and receive Jesus Christ as my personal living Savior. Then tell a pastor or your instructor of your decision, and follow Christ in baptism and church membership.
