2019 DRIVERS' EDUCATION CLASSES BEGIN JANUARY 19.



This course is an instructor-led, faith-based program with a comprehensive video and student manual that is recognized for insurance discounts by major carriers nationwide. The classroom session will be held the first two days of the sessions, followed by three 2-hour drives (to be scheduled by the instructor). The full sessions will last 4 weeks. (Student must be 15 years old when the class begins.)

Christian Driving School is a self-supporting program and requires a minimum of 10 students per class session.
