- WHO?** Students must be 15 years of age. Students from public schools, private schools or home school may enroll.
- WHEN?** Call Culley Seymour at (405) 227-7257 for the next session date.
- WHY?** To develop a style of driving which improves decision-making qualities and performance of driving skills
- TIME?** In-Class Phase: A full 10 hours of instruction Session one Saturday 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. and session two the following Saturday 8:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. or choose the following Monday 4:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m. In-Car Phase: Each student will drive for a total of six hours behind the wheel covering all basic driving maneuvers. The Monday through Friday sessions are from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. Saturday sessions begin from 8:00-10:00, 10:00-12:00, 12:30-14:30 & 14:30-16:30.
- COST?** The cost of the course is \$340 which covers student manuals, test, study guides, materials, diplomas, fuel, insurance premiums, general maintenance on the vehicle, instructor's fee, and other miscellaneous expenses incurred. \$340 is due on the first day of class. There will be a \$20 charge for failing to give 24 hour advanced notice of driving session cancellation, \$10 charge for replacing lost diplomas. No refunds after first class session. Refunds for class canceled due to insufficient enrollment will be made as quickly as possible.
