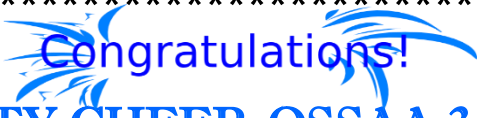

It provides career information for various civilian and military occupations and is an indicator for success in future endeavors, such as college, vocational school, or a military career.
